

The Feed Zambia feeding program

continues every week, in some units we are feeding three times a week while in some twice a week.

Every week we are feeding literally thousands of kids and adults. Last season we had enough rains in many parts of the country even though the rains came late in some of the areas. People were able to plant and have harvested some maize to help them put some food on their tables. Hunger in Zambia was so severe that people ate all they could lay their hands on that was eatable, including wild roots; kids were severely affected. They stopped going to school because they had no energy, as a result of hunger. The number of kids who were attending school classes was going down everyday.

We bring glory to God for all churches, individuals, prayer partners and the whole body of Christ for coming to our aid. The moment we started feeding the young people, the attendance in the schools surrounding our units and bases began to go up. The teachers from Chofoshi in Mansa, were surprised to see many children at school and wondered what had happened. They asked the children that day why many of them came to school, because they had previously not been coming. The kids said "because Teen Missions is now feeding us, we have come to school and from here we will be going to eat nshima at Teen Missions".

This program has literally saved lives from starvation. We are grateful for the lives saved. The number of plates of food served so far is 195,664 as of August 2025. We praise the

Lord for the food provided. We could have done more but the frustration has been the Government restrictions in how many bags of mealie meal you can buy, and acquiring the transportation permits. The impact of the feed Zambia program is far reaching than we can fully fathom, but one thing we know is that thousands of people have been impacted by the program and saved from starvation. The meals were served in 856 villages and depending on the area, some villages would have as many as 500 to 1000 people while in Lufwanyama areas, a village may mean one to 10 homes. In addition to nshima, hundreds of bags of beans, soya pieces, salt, cooking oil, sugar, ground nuts, sausage, and kapenta has been used to feed the Orphans and community members who come to the Units for meals.

The people in the villages near our Units are grateful for the help they have been given. We as a base are grateful to you for your support that allowed us to help the orphans and the people in the communities around us. To the body of Christ in the USA thank you for your compassion love and care you have shown us, during our time of great sufferings. Your support helped save many lives from starvation. We feel loved and supported.
