The Tough Gator 5K Mud Run is an "event with a purpose!"

100% of the proceeds from our annual fundraiser in 2023 were sent to our TMI ministries overseas. The proceeds assisted families and orphans with school fees, uniforms, food, and other daily needs. It was also used in unexpected ways. This is a story from our Malawi country coordinator, Miscious.



"Greetings in Jesus name. When I visited the Wellman Family Rescue Unit,

I found this poor Agogo (grandmother) sitting down. I felt sorry. She does not have anyone to help her. Her house is just by the entrance of our ministries, and she struggles with the rain daily. She did not beg anything from us, but when I saw this, I discussed what we can do to help her." Miscious and the Malawi staff had some bricks to start helping build a house but didn't have cement or other materials needed. Miscious was able to use \$300 from the Mud Run money they had received to build a new house for her. Miscious says that the Agogo appreciates the house and said, "Teen Missions has given her a new life and she has seen the love of God." The chief of the local village said that, "It is a real gesture that Teen Missions is here to show the love of Christ."
