Another job that I have throughout the year is purchasing supplies, so I'll be busy making sure all the supplies that we need for the summer are purchased as well.

I'm excited to share that I have the opportunity this summer again to help lead a team to Santa Cruz, Bolivia to serve at the Escuela Técnica Misionera (School of Missions). This is one of Teen Missions



newest bases. This trip will be more than just a trip—it's a life-changing experience of growth, service, and ministry for the teens and the leaders.

Our project for the team will be building new classrooms for the School of Missions.

These facilities will equip future national missionaries with the tools they need to share the Gospel throughout South America.

Before heading to Bolivia, we'll gather in



Florida for training. It's primitive and challenging—designed to stretch the teens physically, spiritually and emotionally. The teens will attend classes in Bible study, evangelism, music,

puppetry, drama, and construction skills to prepare for both the work and the evangelism ahead.



While in Bolivia, our days will be filled with both construction and ministry. In addition to building, we'll share the Gospel through music, puppets and drama. And the team will also engage in Bible studies and will be learning memory verses.

We're praying for God to use us as His hands and feet—and to do a deep work in our own hearts too.

At the end of the summer, we'll return to Florida for Debrief—a special time of rest, reflection, and preparation for returning home. We'll celebrate what God has done, process what we've experienced, and receive training to stay spiritually strong and involved in ministry back home.

"I will remember the works of the Lord. Yes, I will remember the amazing things you did long ago!" Psalm 77:11

On May 7, 1970, Teen Missions was born—not from a boardroom or a business plan, but from a burning desire in the hearts of men and women who believed God could use young people to change the world. Leading the charge was Robert M. Bland, a man whose years in ministry had opened his eyes to a powerful truth: God doesn't wait for someone to grow up before He calls them. And neither should we.

Bob met countless teenagers who were eager to serve the Lord, only to be told to wait. One young girl's words stayed with him: "But I want to do something for the Lord now—not five years from now," she told him. Her plea echoed the heart of a generation longing to act, to serve, and to go. Bob knew teens had the passion, the energy, and the boldness to follow wherever God would lead.

From that conviction, a bold and unprecedented vision took shape: "Training tomorrow's missionary today." The first Teen Missions team stepped out in faith and traveled to Mexico in 1971. It was the beginning of something extraordinary.

Fifty-five years later, the numbers tell the story—48,000+ teenagers, 120+ countries, and 1,900+ teams have left their mark across the globe. Fifty-five years later, our mission remains the same: "To inspire and equip a new generation to boldly proclaim salvation in Christ alone." (I Peter 2:9)

And that's the story of Teen Missions—a story still being written by teenagers with willing hearts and a God who still does the impossible. When young hearts say "yes" to God, they can impact the world for Jesus!
