Current Needs: Zambia, Madagascar and Mangochi TMI Bases CYCLONE FREDDY ROAD DAMAGE REPORT

Greetings in the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ from Mangochi TMI Base.

I write to report on the road damage caused by the "CYCLONE FREDDY" which has hit the southern region of the country of Malawi. For the past three days, this part of the country has been receiving continuous HEAVY RAINS and STRONG WINDS. This has resulted in serious ROADS DAMAGES, thousands of people dying, and others sustaining serious body injuries and rendered homeless. The damaged roads include the road to and fro Teen Missions base here in Mangochi. The 2 road portions which have been damaged are at a distance of about 1 kilometre away from the base. This means that we can not drive out from here. All our daily important operations, like ministry, picking Bible school supplies, and picking construction supplies are on hold. This calls for an immediate response to fixing this road so that these important operations are recovered. The materials that are needed to fix the road include 30 bags of cement, rocks, two loads of bricks, one load of stones, 10 pieces of liber metals, 10 rolls of tying wire, and transport.
