not achieve it because my father accidentally lost his mind when I was just in the ninth grade. Although I was doing good at school, I had to stop; despite passing all of my classes. I became so sad and hopeless about my life, but my mother encouraged me that God still saw

my wish. The moment I came to the Teen Missions base my heartache went away.

At home, I acted like a little kid. I was discontent unless my mother was next to me. I depended wholly on my parents. But during Boot Camp, I heard a preacher preaching about a biblical statement such as: "when I was a child I talked like a child, I thought as a child, and I reasoned like a child. When I became a man I put away childish things." That statement encouraged me a lot, and so now I have become more mature.

From where I am coming from I could not forgive others' mistakes. If one of my friends stole my things I would become very mean and harsh while talking to that person. I started to hate him or her totally. When I arrived here at Teen Missions, I came to know how to forgive others. For example my soap and detergent were stolen by one of my friends and I found out about it later. But my reaction was different. I was not even angry against them. I thank Jesus, I am able to forgive others now.

During the Commissioning service, I was also inspired when the coordinator explained about how one light can make a change in the middle of the darkness. We held a candle and he lit up all ours through his light. It was an amazing and monumental moment. My mind was changed. I have many brothers that are not yet Christians. If I pursue this training in BMW I will gain knowledge. I will be able to share the Light of Jesus with them. If they see the light of God upon me, as the illustration showed, they will be lit too.

Here at the end I should mention that through the prayers during Boot Camp my father has recovered from his insanity. All the glory goes to God!
